Leading politicians, celebrities and retailers join Cruelty Free International to call on the EU to lead the way in securing an international end to cosmetics animal testing

Brussels, 6 March 2018

Dear Presidents of the European Parliament, Commission and Council of Ministers and Heads of EU Member State governments,

In March, the European Parliament will vote in Strasbourg on a motion that asks the European Union to **take international action to end cosmetics animal testing** everywhere and forever. We would like you to do all you can to support this.

Back in 2003, **the EU showed vision and leadership** by starting the process of banning cosmetics animal testing and the sale of cosmetics products that were tested on animals. Since then, hundreds of thousands of animals' lives have been saved¹ and **unnecessary suffering has been prevented. Innovation in the non-animal testing field has boomed** with advances in modern scientific methods such as in vitro data improving both safety and ethics in cosmetic testing².

In 2013, the full EU testing and marketing bans came into force. Five years on, **the time is right to go one step further**.

The EU has a proven track record and a unique ability to deliver change that not only protects human and animal wellbeing, but also provides **leadership towards more civilised and modern trading economies**. Look at the success of these animal testing laws as evidence. The EU's animal testing ban for cosmetics reflects the public's conviction that cosmetics should not be valued over animals' wellbeing³ and gives inspiration to how our global economies should function in future.

However, even now in 2018, the testing on animals continues. Some 80% of the world's countries still do not have laws preventing cosmetics animal testing – and over half a million animals annually continue to suffer⁴.

You should be proud. As elected parliamentarians, as officials working at all levels of the European Commission and Council, the leadership the EU has shown deserves much credit. Now it's time to work to deliver a global end to cosmetics animal testing and eliminate cruel and unnecessary animal suffering around the world. We are calling for the European Union to use its influence to push for this.
